



## **ELIGIBILITY:**

- Boys 8 years old (8/1/10 - 7/31/11)
- Boys / Girls 9 years old (8/1/09 - 7/31/10)
- Boys / Girls 10 years old (8/1/08 - 7/31/09)
- Boys / Girls 11 years old (8/1/07 - 7/31/08)
- Boys / Girls 12 years old (8/1/06 - 7/31/07)
- Boys / Girls 13 years old (8/1/05 - 7/31/06)

## **TOURNAMENT FORMAT AND GAME RULES:**

- Each team will receive a minimum of 2 games
- All age groups will play four 7-minute quarters. 4 Full timeouts are allowed
- Overtimes will be 3 minutes. An additional timeout will be granted for each overtime period
- Each player is permitted five personal fouls
- All N.J.S.I.A.A high school rules will be followed except for the following:
  - Pressing**
    - Boys U8/Girls U9 can only press the last 2 minutes of game and overtime
    - Boys U9 can only press the last 3 minutes of game and overtime
    - Boys/Girls U10 can only press the 4th quarter and overtime
    - Boys/Girls U11-U13 High School Rules
    - No Pressing by either team if there is a 20-point margin



**Foul Shots – normal rules apply for all divisions except:**

- Girls U9 can start on the first hash inside the foul line. Shooter cannot be first to touch the ball
- Boys U8/Boys U9 must start behind line but can jump over line. Shooter cannot be first to touch the ball

**DIVISION CHAMPIONS**

- A championship game will be played in each division
- If two teams are tied, tie-breakers will be applied in this order:  
**Head to Head Result**
  - Point differential (15 max points per game) for all games played
  - Lowest amount of points allowed in all games
  - Coin toss
- If three teams are tied, tie-breakers will be applied in this order:
  - Best head to head record among the teams that are tied
  - If 3 teams are still tied, point differential (max 15 points per game) for all games played. (If 2 teams remain tied, then head to head tie-breaker.)
  - Coin Toss



## **2020 TOURNAMENT RULES**

- If a Division has 4 teams, each team will play 2 games, and the 1st place and 2nd place team (by record and tiebreakers above) will advance to the Championship game
- If a Division has 5 teams, each team will play 2 games, and the 1st place and 2nd place team (by record and tiebreakers above) will advance to the Championship game
- If a division has 6 teams, there will be two 3-team pools and each team will play the other 2 teams within their pool. The winner of each pool will advance to the championship game
- If a division has 7 teams, there will be one 3-team pool and one 4-team pool and each team will play 2 teams within their pool. The winner of 4-team pool will advance to the championship game. The second place finisher in 4-team pool will play winner of 3-team pool in a semifinal
- If a division has 8 teams, each team will play 2 teams within their pool. The winner of each pool will play the second place team in other pool in a semifinal. Winners of two semifinal game advance to Championship
- If a division has 9 teams, each team plays others in their pool. Three pool winners advance to semifinals plus the Best second-place team determined by point differential
- Trophies will be presented to the winners of each division. There is no runner-up trophy
- An admission fee (\$3 Adults, \$2 kids) will be charged every day except for coaches and players
